ARRIVAL / CAR PARKING

- **All entrants have been emailed these Race Day Instructions which contains a QR code. You need to show this at the main entrance to gain entry to Silverstone Circuit.**
- Access to Silverstone Circuit is from 17.30. Race starts at 19:30. Wheelchair race starts 19:25
- Please note that **NO ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED IN TO THE CIRCUIT**
- You will be directed to the car parking areas
- Please allow enough time to get from the car park, to collect your number and to warm up

YOUR NUMBER

- Please visit the 10k page at <https://www.silsonac.org.uk/silverstone-10k> where you can find the race number allocated to you and keep up to date with race entries.
- You must collect this on the night as it contains your timing chip. Number collection will be at Race HQ in; please follow directions once you have parked.
- Numbers must not be swapped or defaced.
- All Runners are advised to complete the details on the reverse of the number for your own protection.
- The number must be worn on the front of your vest / T shirt.
- If you are running any other of the EMGP series races – please ensure that you **keep this number**.

CHANGING / TOILETS

- Covered changing facilities and unmanned baggage storage will be available in designated pit garages
- Toilets are available in the paddock area

SPECTATORS

- Spectators are welcome but may only watch from the pit wall – you will see the runners just after the start, at the end of the first lap and in the pit lane at the finish.
- There is no spectator access to other areas of the Silverstone Circuit
- Spectators should not cross the pit lane once race finishers have started to use the Pit Lane
- Please always follow the instructions of marshals

PRIZES

- Trophies will be presented in the main pits starting at around 9.00 p.m. Age category prizes will be sent to winners after the event
- There are trophies for the First Man, First Lady, First Wheelchair Athlete, First Team (first four runners to count) and Fastest Motorsport Team (first four runners to count).
- Age category prizes – Men M20, Senior Man, M40 – M80, Ladies F20, Senior Lady, F35 – F80. One trophy/prize per winner.



SILVERSTONE GRAND PRIX 10K

THE SILVERSTONE GRAND PRIX 10K COURSE

- The course is one lap of the main Grand Prix Circuit (blue arrows), followed by one smaller lap (purple arrows)
- The start line (green dot) is on the Wellington Straight whilst the finish line (red dot) will be in the pit lane. Water station is marked by a yellow dot
- To avoid there being anyone on the circuit in the dark, any competitor who does not complete their first lap by **20:25** will be asked to stop
- The race will be run under UK Athletic Rules
- Please always follow the instructions of marshals
- As this is a lap course (even though it is closed to traffic), **UKA rules** (page 365) **do not permit the use of headphones/earphones including bone conduction earphones** and anyone using them will be disqualified.
